Dear friends,

Greetings from Union Christian College, Aluva.

I feel privileged to welcome you all to the Eighth Annual International Session of the Kerala History Congress which will be hosted by Union Christian College, Aluva, and organized by the Department of History. Scheduled for three days from 26th to 28th January 2024, the session is expected to generate critical debates on various themes in history and discuss the latest developments in the sphere. It gives us immense pleasure to extend a most cordial invitation to participate in the deliberations of the session.

The Host

Union Christian College, Aluva was established in 1921 as an ecumenical, Indian Christian initiative in the field of higher education in Kerala. A sprawling green campus spread over 40 acres, the college is located on the banks of river Periyar, about 12 kilometres away from the Cochin International Airport. Affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam, the institution is known for its academic excellence and research potential. The college has 18 academic departments, with around 1900 students and 160 faculty members. The college has been rated as an 'A' Grade institution by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in the fourth cycle with 3.45 points. The college strives to produce intellectually competent, morally upright, and spiritually inspired citizens in the service of the nation. The list of eminent international teachers who have associated with the college in the past includes stalwarts like Canon W. E. S. Holland, Rev. L. W. Hooper, Malcom Muggeridge and Rev. B. G. Crowley. This ethos continues in the form of international collaborations and student exchange programmes with Universities outside India.

From the time of its inception, History has been one of the important disciplines taught in the college. In the early days, it was taught alongside Economics and Philosophy. In 1965, a separate Department of History, offering under-graduate and post-graduate programmes, came to be constituted with Dr. A. K. Baby as the first Head of the Department. Subsequently, in 2000, the department developed into a Research Centre, supervising several research scholars across the state. It was the first of its kind in an aided college in Kerala.

Some of the former students and faculty members who have made important contributions to the academic and public life of India include Prof. Rajan Gurukkal, Prof. Michael Tharakan, Mr. R. B. Sreekumar IPS, Dr. P. J. Cherian and many others. At present, the department has 7 faculty members and about 120 students. Besides the academic courses prescribed by the university, the department encourages research and inter-disciplinary initiatives with the objective of enabling students to think critically and to develop a historical consciousness.

The Sessions

Kerala History Congress is a professional organization of teachers and research students seeking the promotion of rational and secular history of Kerala. The annual sessions of the Kerala History Congress intent to provide platforms for discussing and debating new research and perspectives coming up in historical knowledge on Kerala. It envisages the sessions in such a way as to bring the budding scholars and erudite scholars on a common platform to offer immense possibilities of interaction and exchange of ideas between them.
