Kishore holds a number of important academic positions in the University of Kerala and is a Member of Syndicate and Senate. In addition, he is a member of many standing committees of the University of Kerala. Dr. G. Kishore is a recipient of many recognitions and awards for his remarkable achievements

#### Smt. M. D. Valsamma

The recipient of Padma Shri in 1983 and the Arjuna award in 1982. Being the second Indian women to win an individual Gold Medal at the Asian Games (1986) and a member of the 4x400m Silver-winning Relay Team (1982). Additionally, she made history when the Indian women's 4x400 m relay team entered the finals at the Los Angeles Olympics in 1984.


#### Shri. Tinu Yohannan
