# Dr. Abraham C. Kulangara Scholarship:

Dr. Abraham C. Kulangara is an old student (1942-44) of U C College, and now settled in the USA. He has been awarding six scholarships of Rs. 2000/- each since the year 2005 – 2006, on a merit cum need basis to both B.Sc. and M.Sc. students. In 2011-12, the number of scholarships was increased to 12. Again, in the year 2012, Dr. Kulangara generously donated Rs. 5, 00,000/- as a capital for instituting additional scholarships. By utilizing a major portion of the annual interest accrued from this capital amount, the College has been awarding 15 scholarships each every year as follows:

- One scholarship each to students of final year B. Sc. (Mathematics), B. Sc. (Physics), B. Sc. (Chemistry), B. Sc. (Botany) and B. Sc. (Zoology) on the basis of merit in their previous examinations.
- One scholarship each to final year students of M. Sc. (Mathematics), M. Sc. (Physics), M. Sc. (Chemistry) and M. Sc. (Botany), based on merit in their previous examinations.
- The remaining six scholarships have been awarded to final year students of B. Sc. and M. Sc. Programs based on their merit-cum-need, and decision of scholarship committee. One third share of the interest is to be added to the capital every year

Further, in November 2013, Dr. Abraham C. Kulangara has donated additional amount of Rs.3, 00,000/- to the college. The annual interest of this amount will be used to award nine more scholarships of Rs. 2000/- each for students of MCA program on the basis of recommendation from MCA Department.

# Dr. P. C. Alexander Scholarship

H.E. Dr. P.C.Alexander, former Governor of Maharastra, who was a student in this college in the intermediate class during 1936 – 38, has donated Rs. 1,00,000/- in 1998. A share of the annual interest of the amount (aprox. Rs. 6000/-) will be used for the award of scholarships to eligible students.

#### Vidwan P. G. Nair Endowment

In the year 2000, the children of Vidwan P. Gopalan Nair set up an endowment in U. C. College in their father's name to promote research and advanced studies in Malayalam literature. This has been the single largest endowment in U. C. College's history with a start-up amount of Rs. 11, 00,000. Interest accruing annually from the fund is used to provide research fellowships. In addition, Dr. Sarngadharan established the Vidwan P. G. Nair Loan Scholarship with a contribution of Rs. 2, 00,000 as well.

Since 2007, under the auspices of the Endowment, the Vidwan P. G. Nair Memorial Research

Centre at the Malayalam Department has been annually conducting a comprehensive literary and cultural program over the course of three days. The program consists of seminar presentations by invited leaders in Malayalam literature, and outstanding cultural programs that depict the art and cultural heritage of Kerala. The Malayalam Department needs to be commended for its imaginative development of these events each year which have become an eagerly awaited draw for the whole campus and the community. The seminar themes are carefully selected by the Malayalam Department, and the proceedings are published as books and released during the opening ceremony of the following year's program. In 2014, the original endowment fund (Rs. 11 Lakhs) was supplemented by an additional contribution of Rs. 14, 00,000. This enables the research fellowship value to be raised to be competitive.
