MCA Admissions 2026–2027

1. Online Application

The MCA Programme has a total intake of **120 seats**, comprising:

- **Management Quota:** 60 Seats
- **Merit Quota:** 60 Seats

Candidates seeking admission to the MCA programme must submit an online application through the **College Admission Portal** along with the required supporting documents.

Application Fee

- **Application Fee:** ₹500
 - Applicable for both **Management Quota** and **Merit Quota** applicants.
 - The application fee is **non-refundable under any circumstances**.
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2. Admission Process

Management Quota Admission

Admissions under the Management Quota are conducted directly by the College based on:

- Performance in the **LBS MCA Entrance Examination**
- Marks obtained in the qualifying degree examination

Candidates seeking Management Quota admission should submit their application through the **College Admission Portal**.

Merit Quota Admission

Admissions under the Merit Quota are conducted by the **LBS Centre for Science & Technology** through the **Centralized Allotment Process (CAP)**.

Candidates must:

- Register through the LBS Admission Portal.

- Submit the online CAP application within the prescribed schedule.

3. Eligibility for Admission

Candidates should have:

- Passed any Bachelor's Degree such as **B.E./B.Tech., B.Sc., B.Com., B.A., B.Voc., BCA**, or any other degree recognized by the Government of Kerala and the concerned University.
- Preferably studied **Mathematics** either at the Higher Secondary (10+2) level or at the Graduation level.
- Secured a minimum of:
 - **50% aggregate marks** in the qualifying examination.
 - **45% aggregate marks** for candidates belonging to the reserved categories.

Candidates without a Mathematics background shall be required to undergo a compulsory **Bridge Course in Mathematics**, along with any additional bridge courses in Computer Science, as prescribed by the respective University/Institution.

Note:

- No rounding off of marks to the next higher percentage is permitted.
 - A **valid rank in the LBS MCA Entrance Examination** is mandatory for admission under both Management and Merit Quotas.
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4. Reservation of Seats

5. Preparation of Rank List

Merit Quota

The rank list for Merit Quota admissions shall be prepared and published by the **LBS Centre for Science & Technology** in accordance with the Government norms and the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP).

Management Quota

Admissions under the Management Quota shall be made by the College based on:

- Valid LBS MCA Entrance Examination Rank

- Marks obtained in the qualifying degree examination
- Fulfilment of the eligibility criteria prescribed by the University and the Government.

6. Fee Structure

The fee structure is **common for both Management and Merit Quota admissions.**

7. Documents Required at the Time of Admission

Candidates shall produce the following original documents at the time of admission:

1. LBS MCA Entrance Examination Rank Card.
2. SSLC/10th Certificate (Proof of Date of Birth).
3. Plus Two (Higher Secondary) Mark List and Certificate.
4. Degree Mark Sheets (All Semesters/Years).
5. Degree Certificate or Provisional Degree Certificate.
6. Consolidated Mark List.
7. Transfer Certificate (TC).
8. Conduct Certificate.
9. Migration Certificate (if applicable).
10. Eligibility/Equivalency Certificate (where applicable).
11. Community/Caste Certificate (for eligible reserved category candidates).
12. Non-Creamy Layer Certificate/EWS Certificate (if applicable).
13. Income Certificate (where applicable).
14. Aadhaar Card.
15. Passport-size Photographs (recent).
16. Any other documents required by the University or Government from time to time.

Note: Admission will be confirmed only after verification of all original documents and payment of the prescribed fees. Failure to produce the required documents within the stipulated time may result in cancellation of admission.
